This recently released documentary explores Leonard Bernstein's various facets, as a conductor, a composer, a pianist and most of all a teacher and how he influenced so many people. It includes interviews of his children, former conductor students, orchestra members, collaborators and other acquaintances.

It is the 100th anniversary of the birth of Leonard Bernstein. He was one of the first world-famous American-born conductors and composers.

His best known works include the musicals "On the Town", "Candide and "West Side Story". His religious themed works show his struggle with his Jewish heritage and universal questions of faith.

There will be a short live concert of Bernstein's compositions at 4 pm preceding the showing of the movie.
