We need strong members to help to help us clean out the sanctuary in preparation for the internal repairs to begin. We will be working this Sunday morning, January 12th, starting at 10:30 am. It should not take more than two hours. Please come help out.

Hurricane Repairs Update

We are happy to report the Temple building roof repairs have been completed, and all the windows have been sealed. Now it is time to begin work on the needed inside work so we may regain the use of our beautiful sanctuary in time for the High Holidays.

The board, at the last meeting voted to hire Simpson Environmental Services to perform the asbestos abatement. Simpson is one of the Southeast's largest and most trusted environmental remediation firms. They are fully licensed as a Florida General Contractor and also a Florida Asbestos Contractor. We anticipate work to begin around January 20th. It is anticipated it will take about 4 weeks for the asbestos removal project to be completed. During that period, the entire downstairs and board room will be sealed off and not available for usage by Temple members. If you have to conduct business in the Temple office or the Rabbi's office you will be able to access to the office wing only. All Shabbat services, Hebrew School and other activities will be relocated to the Education Building and Caretakers house during the repairs.
